## Jellicoe Park flagship sporting facility to open in August

The flagship sporting facility constructed by Bayside Council in Jellicoe Park, Pagewood will be officially opened on Saturday 18 August.

"This sports amenities building is largest we have built so far. It is an impressive asset for our community and a great facility for the Pagewood Football Club," Mayor Bill Saravinovski said.

Bayside Council is an advocate of supporting female participation in sport and Pagewood Football Club has an almost equal ratio of male and female participants.

The new building houses four change rooms which provides provision for both male and female change rooms. The facilities also include public toilets, accessible toilets with baby change facilities, canteen, and storage for the sporting clubs, a meeting room and external hand wash.

Jellicoe Park has also received additional embellishments such as a new shade structure for the playground, new perimeter fencing and improved circuit path and connecting pathways to the new building.

A new sports amenities building at Booralee Park with new public toilets, change rooms, canteen and storage areas will also be officially opened on Saturday 18 August.
