## Town Centres Cleaning Program

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Bayside Council has taken delivery of a high-pressure pavement cleaner, equipped with the latest technology, to help keep our Town Centres clean without the use of chemicals.

"This is another example of Bayside's reputation as a leading and progressive Council. Staff are now planning a pavement cleaning program to best cater to all our Town Centres. This program will be fine-tuned over the next 12 months," said Mayor Saravinovski.

In an Australian first Bayside Council's Waste & Cleansing Services is now using a market-leading NC 286R Euro 6 high-pressure pavement cleaner with on-board suction system to clean the pavements in our Town Centres.

A combined system of hot water, high pressure and suction provides a deep clean to paved areas without the use of chemicals.

The unit provides a 50% energy savings, 30% water savings, leaves a dry floor immediately after operation and increases productivity by cleaning up to 1000m<sup>2</sup> per hour.

Dirty water is disposed of responsibly in grey water tanks on-board the transport truck and at Council depots which is subsequently collected by contractors.

The custom designed transport truck is also equipped with a state-of-the-art silent high pressure cleaning unit with two 1000L tanks and 100m hose reel.

This 4-wheel drive, 4-wheel steering hydrostatic compact carrier was also designed to fit under our Town Centre awnings.

This new environmentally-friendly pavement cleaning unit provides exceptional economic performance without the use of chemicals and is equipped with the latest technologies including:

- an on-board clean water 1150L stainless steel tank
- a dirty water 1100L stainless steel tank
- a hand held spray gun for finishing work
- 1.2m wide cleaning bell equipped with high performance rotating joints
- a high pressure cleaning dome for use in places that are difficult to access
