Rockdale dairyman Reginald Annabel was a daredevil and Jenny MacRitchie will be talking about his remarkable story at the Mascot Library.

In the space of a few short years he flew around Australia, under the Harbour Bridge and even built his own plane in his backyard.

In 1934 he was killed at Mascot Aerodrome looping the loop.
