Summer Reading Program Success

Bayside Council would like to thank all residents for supporting the Preschooler Summer Reading Club.

Parents who registered for the program at a Bayside library entered the books they read to their child in a reading log. Those who read 5 books or more are invited to a morning tea with prizes.

This year the Preschooler Summer Reading Club saw 230 participants read 2866 books.

"This is a wonderful result and I would like to thank all parents and carers who took part. I would like to thank our library staff who do a tremendous job running and promoting early literacy programs. It's important the children are introduced to books from an early age," Mayor Bill Saravinovski said.

Rockdale and Eastgardens early literacy programs are now so successful that these libraries are now taking bookings.
