NOTES

1. Existing playground to be demolished and replaced with new lawn area and tree planting
2. Existing amenities to be demolished and replaced with new lawn area and tree planting
3. New accessible loop path provides access through the park from accessible entries
4. Inner loop path links main activity areas, the water feature, playground and amenities
5. Existing trees to be retained and protected. Tree maintenance on Arborist advice
6. Access path from Bryant Street
7. Succession planting of trees along Bryant Street. Staged removal of Coral trees per Arborists advice
8. Upgrade northern entry with feature planting
9. New footpath along West Botany Street, park planting to extend out to path
10. New street trees along West Botany Street, where power poles allow
11. Pedestrian link to Muddy Creek netball fields and C A Redmond Field
12. Southern entry upgrade with new feature planting
13. Accessible parking spaces and path link into park, playground and amenities
14. Existing parking on Ador Avenue
15. New water feature
16. New amenities building
17. Playground with a wide variety of equipment for a range of ages and abilities. Rubber softfall linking accessible equipment and perimeter path
18. BBQ and picnic area located in close proximity to playground and amenities
19. Existing Gazebo

ROCKDALE PARK MASTERPLAN AND UPGRADES

What are we doing?

Bayside Council is implementing the Rockdale Park Masterplan. The Masterplan provides improved facilities for the community and includes:

- Circulation paths providing better connections throughout the park and improved access and entry points on all road frontages;
- Relocated public amenities, including accessible and family friendly facilities;
- A new water feature consisting of shallow pools and water plants as well as reflection ponds, sitting edges and a new bridge crossing;
- A relocated playground catering for all age groups with inclusive play elements and nature play;
- New park furniture including seats, picnic settings, bike racks, drinking fountains, signage and a BBQ.

When are we doing it?

Construction commences in September 2019 and will be completed by April 2020.

Access to this area is restricted with temporary fencing.
For your safety please stay clear of construction zones.
