I am delighted to announce that Bayside Council, via the strategic leadership of Council's General Manager Meredith Wallace, Director City Presentation Mr Colin Clissold, and Council's Manager Waste & Cleansing Services Mr Joe Logiaccio, has been recognised for its dedicated, proficient and highly valued contribution to Local Government, the Environment, and the Waste & Resource Recovery sector.

This year, Bayside Council's Waste & Cleansing Services business unit was recognised with four prestigious awards at the Keep Australia Beautiful NSW Sustainable Cities Awards 2019:

- Winner (Circular Economy Award) – Community Recycling Drop Off Events;
- Winner (Coastal and Waterways Protection Award) – Bayside Beach Litter Prevention Program;
- Winner (Recycled Organics Award) – Community Composting and Worm Farming; and
- Finalist – Overall Sustainable Cities Award.

These award-winning projects form part of Council's Waste Avoidance and Resource Recovery Strategy 2030. Through this vision, Council's Waste & Cleansing Services have strengthened the reputation of Bayside Council as an environmental leader, focused on providing the best economic, environmental, innovative and sustainable solutions for the community.

Council's Waste & Cleansing Services team was also recognised at the Local Government NSW Excellence in the Environment Awards 2019/20 by winning the prestigious State wide

Community Waste Services category for the “Bayside Community Recycling Innovation Hub”.

This innovative program included the use of recycled content within AC14 Reconnophalt road pavement which has been recognised as an industry first in NSW. This new pavement incorporated recycled materials equivalent to 314,558 plastic bags, 25,882 glass bottles, toner from 7,142 used toner cartridges and reclaimed asphalt which may have otherwise been sent to landfill.

This multifaceted project involved the coordination of numerous Council services from Planning, Design, Certification, with all construction being undertaken by Council’s City Works team.

By building meaningful relationships, Council’s Waste & Cleansing Services has delivered exceptional service and empowered the community to take ownership for resource recovery and environmental protection.

Through visionary leadership, passion and determination of our staff, Bayside Council continues to be an industry and Government leader in the areas of resource recovery, community waste services and innovation.

Therefore, I congratulate the General Manager, Director City Presentation, Manager Waste & Cleansing Services, and all the business units involved.
