Tips for enjoying your New Year's Eve:

- It's a good idea to make a designated meeting area in case you or a little one gets lost. Try writing your phone number on the back of the hand, or pick up a **FREE** ID band from one of the Bayside Info Booths.
- If you're going to be at the beach all day remember to wear lots of sunscreen, even if you're in the shade. Don't forget to reapply every 2 hours or immediately after you get out of the water.
- Be sure to bring lots of water. If you run out, don't throw out your bottle! You can refill it again at one of Councils many filtered Water Stations located throughout Cook Park.
- Bayside NYE 2019 is a family friendly event. Antisocial behaviour will not be tolerated. Security and plain clothed police patrol the area.
- No Alcohol Permitted / No Glass Permitted.
- If you're bringing a BBQ, remember hot coals can burn. Dispose of coals in the designated bins and be mindful of others.
- Help keep our city beautiful and leave only your footprints. Place all rubbish in the bins provided.
- Be aware, roads reopen from 10:30pm.

GETTING THERE

PUBLIC TRANSPORT

Public transport is recommended as parking is limited and traffic will be congested due to road closures. Sydney Bus services are available.

PARKING OPTIONS (SEE MAP)

Vehicle access of the area will be restricted. Illegal parking includes parking on or across nature strips, 'No Stopping' zones, footpaths and driveways. Parking is not permitted on Foreshore Road. Illegal parking will be subject to fines and towing. Please park only in designated spaces.

DROP OFF ZONES (SEE MAP)

For persons wishing to bring picnics there are two 2 minute drop off zones from 10am onwards:

- Northern car park at Kyeemagh; and
- Bay Street near Moate Avenue.

MOBILITY ACCESS (SEE MAP)

Limited mobility parking is available in the northern car park at Kyeemagh and part of Bestic Street.

Must display **both** the Australian Disability Parking Permit & the NSW Mobility Parking Scheme Permit.

Accessible viewing area is located on The Grand Parade at Brighton Le Sands opposite Bay Street. Please call 1300 581 299 and state your permit number to prearrange this service.

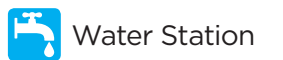
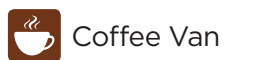
