



## What has been decided?

Council resolved in December 2019 to proceed with the option below and to commence detailed design, a development application and tender documentation for this option.

- A 50 metre outdoor competition pool
- An indoor learn to swim pool
- A 25 metre indoor lap pool
- Adventure slides / major water play / splash pad
- A new building including entrance, amenities, change rooms and café
- New grandstand
- Landscaping works to the open green space
- Health and fitness / gym space
- Community / child minding space





## What's next?

Council is commencing detailed design to prepare a development application and tender documentation, with a target opening date in 2023.

To assist Council in its decision making on the functional design of the updated Aquatic Centre, as well as the proposed delivery, operation and promotion of the Centre, Council will establish a Community Reference Group of people with knowledge of the needs of specific user groups.

Recruitment for this group will be through an Expression of Interest process, to be conducted in February 2020.

Council will also engage with the community during the design process when Council has prepared its concept plans showing how various elements of the updated centre will be arranged.

This will provide the opportunity for all members of the community to comment on the proposed design.
