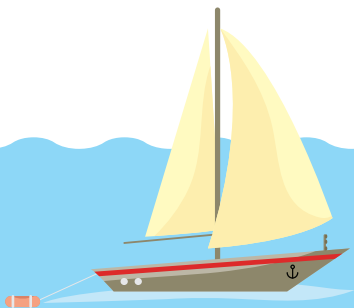
Summer Foreshore Enhancement Program 2020/21

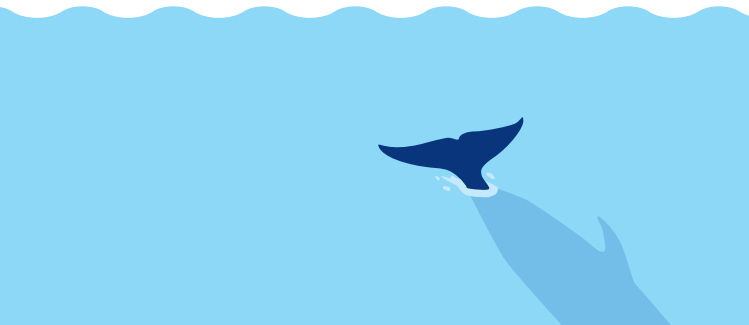

Smoke Free Zones

Breathe Easy

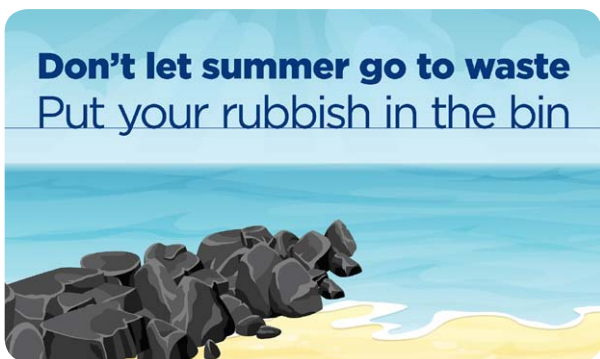
A smoke free zone from the start of the Little Grand Parade (Bestic Street) to the Brighton Kiosk. A 30m smoke free exclusion zone at Dolls Point.

Increased Waste Services and Bins

Council is providing extra rubbish bins, litter collections and beach cleans.

We want to make it easy to keep our beaches, parks and foreshore reserves clean – and protect marine life.



Timed Parking

The demand for parking along the foreshore peaks during spring and summer as the weather gets warmer, resulting in insufficient parking. A three hour turnaround will be trialled this year to give everyone ample opportunity to enjoy the foreshore.



Summer Foreshore Ambassadors

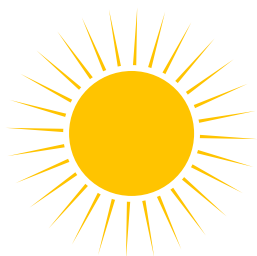
The ambassadors will patrol the foreshore, create public awareness and education and provide public safety announcements. They will also respond to and manage general customer enquiries and monitor crowd behaviour to ensure we are all COVID-Safe.



PWC & Jet Ski Restrictions

We are partnering with NSW Maritime and Police to increase patrols and create new designated no-go zones.

Summer will be safe, clean and fun for everyone if we all play our part. Here's how you can play your part this summer.



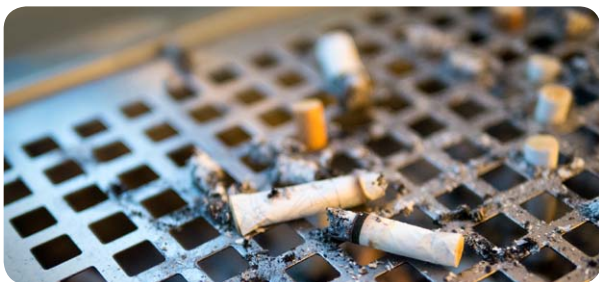
Use the Bins

Butt Out

We encourage all smokers, whether they are at the beach or elsewhere, to dispose of cigarette butts properly to ensure our beaches remain litter free.



Responsible Dog Ownership

We know dogs love our beaches and parks too, so we have an off-leash area at Kyeemagh Beach, between Gate 60 and Gate 61 from 4pm to 10am only.

Please **keep your dogs on a leash** in all public places, including streets and footpaths. Pet owners must carry appropriate waste bags and clean up after their dogs.



Reduce Plastic Waste

Refill Your Bottle

When you are out and about, skip the single-use plastic water bottle and bring your reusable bottle to the beach instead.

You can refill your bottle at one of our **FREE** water refill stations along the foreshore.
