Frequently Asked Questions

Do I need Council Approval?

Development Applicants – separate approval to remove a tree may not be necessary – contact our Customer Service Centre to clarify before completing this form.

You **do NOT** need Council approval to remove or prune a tree if the tree is:

- No higher than 3m and has a girth of no more than 300mm at a height of Im above the ground.
- A species declared to be a noxious weed under the Noxious Weeds Act 1993 or fruit plants identified in Schedule 1 to the Plant Diseases Act 1924.
- A species exempted from the Rockdale Development Control Plan 2013.

Otherwise – YES – you do need approval!

Where do I send my application and payment?

You can pay in person at one of Council's Customer Service Centres – 444-446 Princes Highway **Rockdale** or 152 Bunnerong Road **Eastgardens** (in the Westfield Shopping Centre) or you can post your application and a cheque or money order to Bayside Council, PO Box 21 Rockdale NSW 2216. Or by emailing to CS.applications@bayside.nsw.gov.au and a Customer Service Officer will contact you to organise over the phone card payment of the application fee.

Do I have the right to appeal against a decision made by the Tree Management Officer?

If you are not satisfied with the decision of the Tree Management Officer, you may request that Council's Manager of Parks & Open Space review this decision.

Review of TMO Determination: \$223.00 (AP/TP)

You may also elect at any time to have the matter heard before the Land and Environment Court if you are dissatisfied with the way Council has dealt with your application.

What are my options if I want to prune a tree on my neighbour's property?

You may lodge an application with Council for inspection of a neighbour's tree however any approval for work considered appropriate will be sent to the trees' owner(s).

It is not the role of Council to intervene in neighbourhood disputes regarding trees. Conflicts may be resolved through the Community Justice Centre or, once all other attempts to resolve the matter have been exhausted, an application may be lodged with the Land & Environment Court for resolution under the Trees (Disputes between Neighbour's) Act 2006.
