# **Entry Requirements**

Students in Years 3 to 4 are invited to submit a work that identifies a significant person, building, place or natural feature in the Bayside area. Students should explore what the chosen person or site reveals about the past and why the chosen person or site is important to Bayside's Local History.

Entries may be in written or video format.

#### Written entries must:

- o Be approximately 500 words or one to two A4 pages
- o Include images or illustrations

### Video entries must:

- o Be approximately between three and five minutes in length
- o Include footage and an audio explanation of the chosen site or person
- o If using interviews, should include a release form signed by the interviewee
