Firmstone Reserve - Dog Park Decommission and Construction Notification

What are we doing?

Following community consultation and feedback, the dog park at Firmstone Reserve will be removed and turned into passive open space.

This will also include some minor embellishment works which will provide the following improvements:

- Removal of park entry gates and fencing
- New park seats in new locations
- New picnic setting
- Adjusted park regulation signage
- Removal of the drinking fountain
- Re-turfing

Alternative off leash dog parks are located at Mutch Park and Astrolabe Park.

When are we doing it?

Construction will commence in Autumn 2026, weather permitting.
